Will We Have a Reauthorization Bill?

- Does It Happen?
 - Easier in House
 - Harder in Senate
- Does It Need to Happen?
 - Current law continues to apply in absence of reauthorization.
 - If HEA legislation isn't better than current law, we prefer no reauthorization.
 - Your engagement is critical.
